NOTE: Following acceptance into the program, you will receive a confirmation of your total fees as well as detailed information about making payments.

Program fees include: On-campus room & board (plus refundable dorm deposit) and use of Perrotis College facilities; tuition and academic credit; administration and orientation fees; organized trips and excursions; and mandatory health insurance (by a Greek carrier) for the duration of the program.

Program fees and optional costs do not include: Transportation expenses to and from Thessaloniki, Greece; individual trips and excursions that are not part of the program; meals and personal expenses during trips and excursions; pocket money and visa/residence permit application fees.

Visa and residence permit application fees (as applicable) are paid by individual participants, in local currency, directly to the Greek authority issuing the visa and/or residence permit. Visa fees are approximately US \$100, residence permit plus related fees (where applicable) are approximately 170€ (roughly US\$250)
