


- Students will receive credit (3 hours) for EE/GEOL/MTEOR/NREM 489/589
- The content of the course will be delivered in 3 parts:
 - An online mini-course beginning in the second half of the spring semester
 - 3 in person meetings for lecture/discussion related to course content and planning for the overseas travel
- In country portion: one week in the UK based in Guildford, Surrey in association with the University of Surrey

Where is Guildford?



Half-semester spring online class + 1 week in the UNITED KINGDOM May 7-15, 2017

- ✓ Study how satellites view and measure properties on Earth using visible light, infrared and thermal energy, imaging radar, and lasers.
- ✓ Learn how these images are used in different applications including: disaster response, precision agriculture, geology, forestry.
- ✓ The fundamentals of electromagnetic radiation are presented without extensive mathematics (no calculus required).
- ✓ Students will tour the Surrey Satellite Technology Ltd. (SSTL) company where satellites are manufactured and controlled in orbit.

- *U. Surrey campus is a 10-15 minute walk from the city Centre and train station.*
- Faculty seminars one day at Surrey Space Centre
- Guildford is 30 miles south-west of **London** with easy train service
- Included side trips are:
 - Stonehenge and Salisbury
 - British Museum, Science Museum, Buckingham Palace
 - Royal Observatory Greenwich, Nautical Museum
- One day of students' choice!


