Programs

- 2 4 week long summer schools
- Semester or year long study abroad
- 10 week summer research internship

- Apply first at ISUAbroad
- When nominated apply at RWTH

Summer schools

- Deadline: March 15, 2017
- 1-2 credits towards ISU degree
- Subjects not necessarily available at ISU
 - Automotive and mobility studies
 - Mechatronic systems engineering and product innovation
 - Automation and simulation
 - Robotics for future industrial applications
 - Production technology meets industry 4.0
- Social events
- Interaction with German and other international Students
- Cost: about \$3500 to \$5500 depending on program
 - Scholarships from RWTH available


Semester/Academic year Deadline: Nov. 30, 2016

- Self-planned program in conjunction with your degree program
 - Technical electives
 - Research
 - Core-classes
- Courses in English and German
- Works for LCP internship
- Talk with engineering international program office and program coordinator early

UROP summer research internship

May 22 - End of July 28, 2017

- 10 week program
 - 2 weeks intensive German, and 'Fit for UROP workshop'
 - No previous German required
 - 8 week research internship
- Receive 4 credits at ISU
 - 3 credits 300-level engineering
 - 1 credit 100-level language
- Social events
- Excursions, tours



Minimum Requirements

- US or Canadian Citizenship
- GPA 3.2 or higher
- 2nd or 3rd year student in Engineering
 - Graduation not until the Spring semester following the summer participating in the program
 - Some sophomore engineering classes




Cost

- Approximately \$3,660
 - Including partial or full tuition scholarship
- Aachen can pay up to 1,850
 Euro scholarship (about \$2,050)
- Actual cost could be as low as \$1,600
